## **Headlines**

<u>Community Safety Forum:</u> Next meeting is 9<sup>th</sup> January 2013 - starting at 7:30pm. At the United Reformed Church Hall, West Street, Malmesbury.

<u>Funding:</u> We have received several small donations for Transition Malmesbury through localgiving.com. This allows us to take advantage of their matched funding scheme and reclamation of Gift Aid. Localgiving's service is available for use by community groups and charities. <u>Malmesbury Xmas Fayre:</u> We had a joint stall with Malmesbury Victoria FC at the Xmas Fayre on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November helping them to raise some funds to help with the flood damage and with lots of information about the work of MVCAP and its partners.

Malmesbury Area Pathfinders (Walks Group): Following the successful launch of the Malmesbury Bridges Walk we are now concentrating upon developing a new trail named the *White Walls Way*. This will be a set of walks forming a large circular trail about 20 miles long. Within the main trail there will be shorter circular walks and links to other regional and national trails. The main routes have been agreed and we are now in the process of producing the detail needed for publication of the route online later in the year.
