The whole of the village of Coombe Bissett will benefit from the resurfacing as it is the main road leading to the village hall, recreation ground and school. The upper part of Shutts Lane, where the improvements are required is an extension to the road used by parents at the village primary school. This is an expanding school with numbers doubling over the past few years and parents used the road for parking to deliver and collect children, as well as school functions. At the present, children walk through many potholes and gouges caused by cars. The kerbstones will hopefully provide a much better boundry, and there will be considerably less risk of accidents occuring. There is a busy cricket club in Coombe Bissett for parishoners of all ages who will be able to travel and walk safely to play. there is a park at the recreation ground and children will be able to get there more safely. The road improvements are essential for access to the village hall, which is widely used by the local community which includes men, momen and children, of all ages. The village hall is well used by many groups including the Drama Club, Phoenix Club, Badminton Club, Indoor Bowls Club, Children's Parties, weddings and the Parish Council.

It is intended that Wiltshire Council will adopt the road once resurfaced.

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Coombe Bissett carried out a survey of Coombe Bissett and Homington residents asking for agreement to increase the precept for 2 years. this was agreed and means that £16,000 will have been raised by the end of the 2010/11 financial year. We are therefore seeking a grant of £5,000 from the Area Boards to cover the rest of the costs. Everyone in the village who uses the school, village hall and recreational field will benefit from the resurfacing of Shutts Lane. We will know that it is making a difference by the positive comments from users. It will provide a safe surface to work and travel on. Shutts Lane is not on the Council's road network. Although it is a public right of way (RoW) the RoW department have no funding available and are unlikely to have adequate resources over the next few years. The Parish Council have therefore decided that something must be done for the residents of Coombe Bissett and Homington. It is intended that Wiltshire Council will adopt the road once resurfaced.
