Local residents suffering from a wide range of mental health illnesses and disabilities in Melksham and the surrounding areas will benefit from this project. We estimate 15 people per week will benefit from the project, ie a total of 780 over the course of a year. Project outcomes: The benefits are as follows:- 1. An increased ability amongst those suffering mental distress to manage daily tasks and lead fulfilling lives- people getting better chances in life and playing a full part in society. 2. A reduction in isolation amongst residents suffering mental distress- better access to support and services and stronger communities with citizens working together to tackle mental health problems. 3. An increased awareness of a wide spectrum of mental disorders leading to increased understanding, reduced stigma and community support for sufferers- healthier communities. 4. Enabling of social participation and empowerment by providing access to information, advice, peer support networks and personalised services. 5. Helping people with mental health issues build confidence and resilience. 6. The project will also help the service users build self esteem, become more active citizens, have greater well being and find support and friendship. How our project links to local priorities: Having reviewed the Melksham Area Board's local priorities we consider that our project links with the following priorities:- 1. Community Development and Inclusion with the priority being to reach lonely people. 2. Health and Well Being- Ensure efficient use of the NHS. Our project reduces the burden on the statutory bodies in the provision of mental health care with mental health service users attending the new Melksham group. Service users are often referred by the NHS to our self help peer support social groups, thus helping to ensure the efficiency of the NHS.

14. How will you monitor this?

We have various methods of collecting evidence (both objective and subjective) that measure a range of key indicators that show our project is working and is making a difference. Key indicators include: attendance records, number of new attendees, levels of confidence and any

changes, levels of participation and contribution to the group and over time, contribution and expression of their own views and experiences, interaction levels with other members of the group, reduction in isolation through friendships and activity outside the group, ability to deal with challenge and self-challenge, levels of personal development and progression on trying new activities, attendance at other organisations, clients attending less frequently and requiring less support, feedback where possible from families and friends, returning to full time employment or voluntary work and improvements in physical health and wellbeing.

15. If your project will continue after the Wiltshire Council funding runs out, how will you continue to fund it?

The capital items will be one off purchases. The project itself will be continued to be funded by external sources. The costs to be funded include part time sessional worker's wages, activity costs (art, yoga, photography, meditation, poem reading etc), volunteer expenses and supervision. Wiltshire Mind is extensivly fundraising and is an ongoing exercise and we are confident of the project being able to be continually funded.
