Why Community First?

With funding from Wiltshire Council, Community First provides a range of support to Community Transport schemes:

- Operational advice, concessionary fares claim assistance, training, funding support, committee assistance, new service development
- Advice to communities wishing to assist people without access to transport
- Wiltshire Community Transport Development Fund Funding of up to £20K for communities to develop existing CT schemes / develop new CT initiatives





What is Community Transport?

- Any transport service, which is designed, specified, controlled, or otherwise developed by the communities it serves, and which is provided in direct response to the identified needs of those communities
- Community transport is a term covering a wide range of transport solutions usually developed to cover a specifically identified transport need, typically run by the voluntary sector for the local community on a not for profit basis.
