This project will help meet the Parish plan objective of developing the remaining ameneties in Minety many of which have been lost in recent years. Attracting more children and young families to Minety through a well equiped Pre School is key to sustaining this rural community.

How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

The need for this project became more pronounced as the Pre-School began to attract more children over the last year, many of whom selected the pre-school because of its large garden area (including vegetable patch!) not seen in many other pre-schools in the area. However the poor weather over the last few years (summers included!) regularly turned the garden area into a muddy no-go zone preventing the children from playing outside which is seen as a key element of the school day. In addition there was no adequate surface within the garden to ride bikes and scooters which is considered great exercise for the children. This project will make approximately 20% of the garden area an all weather surface making it possible for the children to go outside in all weathers.

Any other information about your project.

This project will benefit the growing number of children in the local community who attend the pre-school and also enable us to potentially offer "Stay and Play" sessions to the wider community and older age groups during the school holidays. We are currently trialing this fund raising idea and charging £1.50 per child for each session. The all weather play area would make these sessions even more attractive to parents and young children in the area.
