Project Title/Name	BUS SHELTER AT CHILVESTER CALNE
Please tell us about the project /activity you want to organise/deliver and why?	<p><i>The neccessity for a bus shelter with resting bar has been required for many years for the use of residents of all ages from the adjacent Lansdowne Park housing area. A base and space was allocated some years ago when the development was built, but lacked the shelter required.</i></p> <p><i>This bus stop for the 55 route from Chippenham and Swindon towards the centre of Calne is used to connect to other services.</i></p> <p><i>The issue has been referred to the CATG group but, with competing priorities, it has not to date been successful in being implemented. Feedback from discussions held at the last CATG meeting suggest that this group recognise this as an aspirational project and would support the initiative</i></p> <p><i>The Town Council has informally agreed that it is prepared to commit to undertake maintenance of a shelter if it is installed by the Area Board.I await to receive written confirmation.</i></p>

How will the local community benefit?	The local community of all ages will benefit to be able to shelter from adverse weather whilst waiting for bus pick up and drop off times. It will also encourage greater use of public transport and reduction of car use.
