Headlines

- Budget and Precept - 2014/15
The Parish Council have agreed its budget for 2014/15 and will retain the same level of precept on Wiltshire Council as in 2013/14: i.e. £8,500 gross of grant from Wiltshire Council.

- Neighbourhood Planning
The Parish Council has agreed to organise a future meeting to discuss the possibility of drafting a Neighbourhood Plan for the village and, in due course, residents and other organisations operating in the village will be invited to contribute to this important exercise.

- Parking on grass verges in the village
Following the meeting of the Community Area Transport Group (CATG) on 27th January 2014, Wiltshire Council will be costing a scheme to alleviate damage to verges caused by parked cars. An application for Area Board funding will then be considered further.

- Defibrillator
The Parish Council has been invited to consider hosting a presentation on the life-saving potential of purchasing community-based defibrillators. Local organisations and other parish councils will be invited to attend.
