A picnic table with wheel chair access was recently installed so the path needs to be suitable for both wheelchairs and pushchairs. This path is also a natural route from one part of the village to access the Post Office stores thus avoiding the main road, where in parts there is no pavement.

The Goddards Lane play area is located about 200 yards from The Village Green and is focal meeting place for all residents of all ages, whilst the children play on the equipment being provided by the Parish Council parents/grandparents meet & socialise.
