Culture, Recreation, Heritage and the Arts - the club will contribute to giving access to a wide range of leisure, sporting, social and cultural activities by providing a specific opportunity for women and young girls to access the sport. The Club will equally offer Volunteering opportunities, Officiating opportunities and Coaching opportunities to both Junior and Adult members of the Community should they wish to become involved in the management of the Club.

How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?

On the first night of our Back to Netball Launch we had 28 women and girls aged 16+ attend with 6 others making enquiries but being turned away because the numbers were too high. Malmesbury Netball Club is a brand new community group and has been developed in response to a local need for a regular activity session for women to attend. Netball has been identified as an opportunity due to a lack of a local club and already the club has 28 people attending with 20 more showing an interest in participating.

The benefit of this project is involving women from a wide variety of backgrounds within the local community area and providing them with a forum to meet people, make new friends, take up regular exercise and encouraging them to feel part of a sociable, healthy lifestyle. The majority of ladies that attend are local mums. Due to busy home lives and work schedules which frequently involve unsociable and varying shifts, result in not being able to make best use of gym membership.

The Netball club provides an opportunity to attend wherever possible and pay on the night. Many of the ladies appreciate this as they don't like being alienated and consequently put off by not being able to commit to attending an activity every week. We are open to all ages and currently have participants between the age of 16 and 54. We need to invest in equipment and other resources in order to provide for the interest that has been sparked by our project.

Any other information about your project.

The Club has elected a Chairperson, Secretary and Treasurer and has identified and retained a qualified UKCC Level 2 Netball Coach to deliver the sessions.

Ann Napper at Malmesbury School has given us her full support and she is encouraging her school girls to join the Netball Club in order for them to achieve the five hour offer. Ann has also joined the club herself as a member. In addition, we have sought and gained the support of Alex Muse, Wiltshire Council Sports Development Manager, Sophie Warner Wiltshire Netball Development Officer, Andy Donald The Activity Zone Centre Manager & Jane Davies DC Leisure Sports Development Manager. All are keen to ensure that we are able to build and grow the Netball Club in Malmesbury.

We have already begun to learn officiating with opportunities for all members to begin to umpire. We hope to train ourselves up to be able to participate in league games in the future, but in the meantime we wish to host friendly matches against other netball groups in the surrounding area.

We will be asking participants to contribute £3.00 per session to pay for the hall hire if 10 sessions are paid for in advance or £4.00 per session if they just wish to pay and play on a flexible basis. In order for the Club to be sustainable it is felt by all members that we need to become self sufficient when it comes to income in order to pay for our annual outgoings

As the Club becomes established we will also be looking to hold fundraising activities in the Community to not only raise funds but also raise awareness of the netball Club.

If you were not awarded the full amount requested, what would be the impact on your project?

The project could not run because we are not be able to purchase the necessary equipment or club kit needed to deliver varied and appropriate training or for the Club.

We would also be unable to pay for the sports hall hire whilst the club becomes established.

How will you know whether your project has made a difference in the community?

The project will make a difference in the community, by the increased numbers of ladies that would like to take up the opportunity to be involved within the club. Also by their personal development, those ladies that want to support the club further by attending coaching and umpiring courses. The project will not only increase people's fitness, but we will also be able to see a significant increase in confidence, interaction within the community and improving their general health.
