NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wiltshire Council in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes the installation of a "PUFFIN" (Pedestrian User-Friendly Intelligent) Crossing, a form of traffic signal-controlled crossing in A4 Bridewell Street, Marlborough at a point approximately 18 metres north west of the centre of its roundabout junction with A4 High Street and A345 Pewsey Road, as shown on the plan below.
