There is currently no provision for young people within this rural village; young people and other members of the local community (including Great Bedwyn Parish council) recognise this as being of utmost importance. A committee of trustees has been formed and the support of the Great Bedwyn British Legion secured with the provision of a dedicated room for the Youth Group and access to the other club facilities eg large hall area, pool room Certain facilities eg computers, printers and copiers will be available at other times to other members of the community. Several young people have expressed an interest in joining a Youth Council to continue dialogue with the community; this will encourage the involvment of young people within the parish and allow young people to have an identity within the wider community. Success will be monitored by numbers attending the group, feedback from the Youth Forum, open discussions and questionnaires. A questionnaire is currently being circulated to young people in the parish.
