Overview

As shown at the start of this report the performance data for a 12 month period, to Dec 2014 is positive with **10.4 % less crime** that the previous year. This means that there have been 253 less victims over the past 12 month period.

You will see from the graph that we have maintained every area as a reduction against the previous 12 month period for the 3rd Area Board in a row, I am particularly proud of the team for this as they really are passionate about making Trowbridge the safest town it can possibly be.

Currently within Trowbridge I have 2 vacancies for PCSO's, and I think I have managed to secure 2 new recruits to be posted here when they finish their training in March. They will be fully trained 'on the job' and chipped in the 'Trowbridge Way' to ensure that visibility and accesibility remain at the heart of our policing.

Unfortunately I am out of force for 10 days in March and this coincides with the area board, so I will be ably represented by either Gill Hughes or Jim Suter.
