Project Summary: Despite a close link with the British Army there is no				

public war memorial in Tidworth. The anniversary of WW1 provides an opportunity to commemorate the sacrifice made by local residents to the defence of the United Kingdom. A group of local residents have come together to construct a war memorial in Tidworth. The Tidworth War Memorial Committee was established to fund and erect a War Memorial to coincide with the centenary of the ending of WW1. Fundraising has begun and the design of the Memorial is now underway to be located in the grounds of the Tidworth Community Centre.

Please tell us WHO will benefit and HOW they will benefit from your project and benefit your local community: The whole community of Tidworth will benefit from this project. It will link across both the military and civilian populations of Tidworth providing a unifying platform for commemoration of Remembrance that belongs to both communities that is belonging to both.
