Phoenix Badminton Club is a premier club within the Badminton England set up. This means we are child friendly and have undergone not only our initial audit but annual audits since the award in 2007. We have joined the Community Badminton Network (CBN) which has been established in the Mid and West Wilts catchment areas and involves schools, councils, leisure operatives, the county association, the governing body and our club. The concept is to establish opportunity for schools to participate in badminton and for the club to provide a gateway for the juniors to carry on in the sport. The equipment requested will show that we are an organisation with high standards, have the ability to provide a safe environment for the juniors with our registered coaches. The result should be to provide good quality players for clubs in the Mid and West Wilts areas and create a sustainable path into badminton and keep the future of the game secure. By working with our two senior schools and our badminton festivals involving all the junior schools and using our base at John of Gaunt school we hope to give opportunity to any junior who wishes to participate in the sport.
