| 500ml of Soil (in a tub or paper bag) | 1 x Bat Origami Kit & Fun Facts |
| 100g of Flour (in a paper bag) | 1 x Fox Origami Kit & Fun Facts |
| 1 x Coconut Shell or Recycled Cup-shaped Piece | 1 x Protect the Planet Booklet |

Bamboo Bug House
You will need: All of the Bamboo & the long piece of twine

1. Bundle all the bamboo together
2. Tie lightly around the middle with the twine and wrap the rest of twine around multiple times until it's nice & secure. *Make sure to leave a little extra twine so you can make a loop for hanging.
3. Hang your bug house somewhere sheltered and shaded like near a rose bush or tree.

Some residents might include solitary bees and ladybirds which can have other benefits to the garden too! It's a win-win!
