- The Serious Collision Investigation Team (SCIT) has already been called out to 19 of the most serious road traffic collisions since January (where injuries sustained are the most serious) – compared to 20 incidents for the entirety of last year.

What are the Fatal Five?

- Careless driving
- Drink and drug driving
- Not wearing a seatbelt
- Distracted (using a mobile phone)
- Speeding

Road users who commit one of the Fatal Five offences are far more likely to be involved in a fatal collision than those who do not.

People are dying on our roads as a result of motorists' poor driving, reckless decisions and momentary lapses in concentration.

Fatal collisions are heart-breaking – for the family, for the community, and for the responding emergency services staff who have to witness the tragedy and subsequent aftermath and we've seen too many this year already.

Stopping any more deaths from occurring as a result of something unnecessary and totally avoidable is a top priority for us.

Across the Summer, our Community Policing Teams, along with speed enforcement officers and the Roads Policing Unit will be making sure motorists are being safe and driving smart.

Officers on Project Zero patrols in Devizes and the surrounding area detected 79 road related offences during a day of action this week.

Project Zero is a roads policing operation held every Wednesday at a different location in the county. It sees officers targeting drivers committing any of the fatal five offences in a bid to reduce the number of casualties on our roads.

While the work taking place is very much everyday work for our RPU officers, the project sees the department intensify resources to target those who are driving at excess speed, drink/drug driving, using a phone while driving, not wearing a seatbelt or driving in a careless or dangerous manner.

On Wednesday this week, a total of 79 offences were detected ranging from excess speed including S5mph in a 30mph area in Avebury, defective tyres, lack of seatbelts and mobile phone use.

As the team moved towards Marlborough to conduct further patrols, they were overtaken by an Audi with the driver committing a double white line offence.

A/Insp Will Ayres said: "The RPU team were working alongside the speed enforcement officers during the day of action, targeting drivers failing to drive safely.

"This month, Wiltshire Police is making road safety a priority, and officers from all teams across the county are conducting Project Zero patrols in a bid to educate drivers of the consequences of committing any of the fatal five offences following a high number of serious injury and fatal collisions."
