## Information sheet: **CSW Criteria and Thresholds**



Guidance on criteria and thresholds

In a 20mph speed limit the following criteria will be applied; 20 to 24mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = No Further Action (NFA) 24.1 to 38.9 mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = eligible for Community Speed Watch Over 39mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = Subject to Police enforcement

In a 30mph speed limit the following criteria will be applied; 30 to 35mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = No Further Action (NFA) 35.1 to 42 mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = eligible for Community Speed Watch Over 42 mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = Subject to Police enforcement

In a 40mph speed limit the following criteria will be applied; 40 to 46 mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = No Further Action (NFA) 46.1 to 50 mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = eligible for Community Speed Watch Over 50 mph 85<sup>th</sup> percentile = Subject to Police enforcement

## Additional notes

Community Speed Watch does not operate in speed limits over 40mph.

Community Speed Watch does not operate in 20mph Zones.

## **CSW Speed Limit Checks – Thresholds**

20mph up to 24mph 30mph up to 35mph 40mph up to 46mph

## **Excessive Speeders - Thresholds**

20mph 30mph+ 30mph 45mph+ 40mph 60mph+
