The Salisbury Area Board’s youth panel met on Monday 28 November, including attendances from Cllr Hocking (Salisbury Area Board Chair), Karlene Jammeh (Area Board Delivery Officer), and the Youth Ambassadors from Wiltshire Creative.

Grant applications were reviewed that provide positive activities for young people aged 13-19 or up to 25 with SEND and seek to address the local priorities for Salisbury:



- ❖ Youth engagement, employment and positive activity opportunities
- ❖ Addressing climate change
- ❖ Supporting positive mental health and wellbeing
- ❖ Supporting under-represented groups
- ❖ Improving transport and access

The total amount in the Youth grants fund for 2022/23 is £9,927.00
