Headlines/Key Successes

A village Litter Pick took place on Saturday 11th March 2023. Many thanks go to the 7 volunteers
who took part and collected 12 bags of rubbish, which is less than normal (16-18 bags on previous
litter picks). Everleigh appears to be getting cleaner!

Projects

- We have made good progress on our Everleigh Enhancement Plan over the past 2 years.
 Achievements include: a circular bench by The Crown bus shelter; a new all weather bench by the playground with views across Salisbury Plain; two caution horses signs on Netheravon Road; a floral garden on the embankment in Everleigh Centre; a superb village map to support delivery drivers by the bus stop layby; and the establishment of flower planters throughout the village.
- This year our priorities will be a new all weather bench in Everleigh Centre overlooking the floral garden, two additional planters to build on the success of that project and a Christmas Tree in December in Everleigh Centre.

Forthcoming events/Diary dates

- Work Party: Saturday 15th April at 9.30am until noon, to tidy up and maintain our playground.
- **King's Coronation Celebration**: Saturday 6th May. We are planning a large scale village event at the playground/Jubilee field to celebrate the Royal Coronation.
- Walk the Parish Boundary: Sunday 16th July. We intend to walk the parish boundary to commemorate the ancient ceremony of *Beating the Bounds of Everleigh Parish*. The plan is to assemble at 9am at V Tank Crossing/Weatherhill Firs situated 1km south of The Crown on the Netheravon Rd, and then conduct a leisurely 8 mile+ hike around most of our scenic parish boundary, to finish at about 1pm.
