Information & Advice

The Information & Advice service provides comprehensive information and advice on a wide range of issues including:

- welfare benefits and money;
- arranging care and support;
- housing options; finding local services and later life planning.

The I&A team can help people to complete benefit applications through a dedicated team of volunteers. Last year we helped people to claim £2.3 million!





Wellbeing Service

 Our Wellbeing service provides short-term support to help older people regain their confidence

 Wellbeing also provides telephone befriending for older people for an indefinite period. This is generally a weekly telephone call with the aim of providing social contact and signposting to other forms of support.





Wellbeing Checks with Meals

- A two-course hot meal (main meal and dessert) is delivered to people's homes
- It is available 364 days a year
- As part of the wider Age UK Wiltshire team, the Wellbeing Checks with Meals staff can provide a direct link to other AUKW services.
- Currently in Wiltshire, Swindon and parts of Bath and Gloucester. Coming soon to Southampton!






Fitness & Friendship

Winter Fuel Payments








To help cover heating costs over the winter months.

An annual tax-free payment for households that include someone born on or before 22 September 1958 (for 2024-25)

Winter 2024/25 you will be eligible if in receipt of:

- Pension Credit
- Universal Credit
- Income Support



Who might be eligible for Pension Credit?



Check if you are eligible use our <u>benefits calculator</u>
There are two parts to Pension Credit

1. Guarantee Credit

- If you've reached State Pension age.
- And if your weekly income is less than:
 - o£218.15 if you're single
 - o£332.95 if you're a couple.



2. Savings Credit?

• There isn't a savings limit for Pension Credit. However, if you have over £10,000 in savings, this will affect how much you receive.

• If you're a mixed age couple, you normally have to claim <u>Universal Credit</u> until you've both reached State Pension age. Then you might be eligible to claim Pension Credit as a couple.

How much Winter Fuel Payment could you get?

• If you are over State Pension age and receive a qualifying benefit, you could get £200 towards your bills.

• If you are over 80, you could get £300 to help with your bills in winter this year. Payments are made to the person claiming the benefit and are for the household.

How to claim Pension Credit



Claim online on GOV.UK

Call Pension Credit claim line on **0800 99 1234** (open Monday to Friday, 8am-6pm)

Have the following details to hand before you get started:

- o your National Insurance number
- o your bank account details
- o information about your income, savings and investments
- o information about your pension (if you have one)
- details of any housing costs you have (such as a mortgage, interest payments or service charges)
- o your partner's details, if you have a partner.
