Neighbourhood Policing Week of Action

This week marks what the College of Policing brand as the “Neighbourhood Policing Week of Action”.

Public Order Offences – 5 offences is enough to trigger an exceptional High in Bradford on Avon, such is the low crime rate. There are no connections between the offences. Two are neighbour disputes and one is a Road Rage incident.

Two incidents have been Charged; two are still under investigation and one has been filed 'No Further Action'.

Burglaries	<p>We've retained this Priority for another Month, due to its fairly significant impact.</p> <p>There was only one Burglary in the Bradford on Avon area this month, but there is a series ongoing in adjacent Melksham, so we are continuing to focus on this.</p> <p>SelectaDNA Kits are being delivered and Target Hardening advice is being offered to try and minimise the impact of offending and boost our chances of catching offenders if locations are targeted again.</p>
