Project Title/Name	Fish Bypass project at Teffont Mill		
Please tell us about the project /activity you want to organise/deliver and why? <i>Important: This section is limited to 900 characters only (inclusive of spaces).</i>	<p>Recent fish survey results demonstrate that the weir at Teffont Mill is causing a barrier to fish migration, stopping fish species moving up-stream. At present, there is a poorly designed by-pass channel around the weir, which with moderate intervention would allow fish to pass the weir with minimal effort. There are some structural concerns (under the footpath), which can be resolved at the same time. There is also an historic bypass channel on the opposite side of the weir, with additional backwater habitat. The possibility to enhance both channels and improve the redundant backwater habitat is great.</p> <p>This project proposal is to allocate £5,000 to put together a costed proposal to apply for funding from a final round of European Funding (deadline: end of March 2018), which is currently under-subscribed. If this funding is not secured, an application to the Water Environment Grant scheme administered by the Environment Agency will be submitted, which has a deadline in late April 2018. If both bids are unsuccessful there will be a costed proposal/design in place which can be used to submit for any funding opportunities which arise.</p>

What evidence is there that this project/activity needs to take place/be funded by the area board?	In the last round of fish surveys undertaken by the Environment Agency above and below the weir there were stark differences in the numbers and diversity of fish species. Below the weir, there were nine separate species of fish, including high numbers of Atlantic Salmon (54 - juvenile). Above the weir, there were just four species (mainly stocked Trout) and only 1 Atlantic Salmon. These surveys were undertaken between 2015/17 and therefore provide a good representation of current stocks.

How will the local community benefit?	With more fish upstream and more habitat accessible (= increased fish) there will be knock-on beneficial effects for other species such as Otter, Kingfisher and Heron. The benefit to the local community will also include an increased fishing opportunity upstream of the weir.
