4	£1,600 remaining in the Health and Wellbeing budget for 2017/18. Funding agreed at Area Board meeting on 11 October 2017 to extend Health and Wellbeing Champion funding until end of March 2018. Val O'Keefe now working for Wilton CLT, need to find host organisation for Ann-Marie Dean.				
5	Information shared about new toolkit. <b>ACTION – Steve to circulate link.</b> Jo raised issue with money spent on toolkit rather than services.				
6	Support, Empower, Advocate and Promote. John provides advocacy support for military across Wiltshire.

Trend seems to be that people are ok for first year or two after leaving but as support network changes issues can arise.  Wider issue of rough sleeping discussed.  <b>ACTION – Steve to circulate information to group.</b></p>
