If this funding is not secured, an application to the Water Environment Grant scheme administered by the Environment Agency will be submitted, which has a deadline in late April 2018. Works to be completed between August – October 2018 What evidence is there that this In the last round of fish surveys undertaken by the Environment Agency project/activity needs to take place/be above and below the weir there were stark differences in the numbers and funded by the area board? diversity of fish species. Below the weir, there were nine separate species of fish, including high numbers of Atlantic Salmon (54 - juvenile). Above the weir, there were just four species (mainly stocked Trout) and only 1 Atlantic Salmon. These surveys were undertaken between 2015/17 and therefore provide a good representation of current stocks.

·	With more fish upstream and more habitat accessible (= increased fish) there will be knock-on beneficial effects for other species such as Otter, Kingfisher and Heron. The benefit to the local community will also include an increased fishing opportunity upstream of the weir.
