closes to the public. All security staff to wear clothing that clearly identifies them at all times. Door supervisors to sign in and sign out. When the premises trades as a nightclub across all parts of the business, at least two door supervisors will be placed at the main entrance after 9pm when the premises provides regulated entertainment.
