


Op SCEPTRE- There have been several national Sceptre weeks of action since July 2015 in an attempt to counter a nationwide rise in knife crime.

All forces in England and Wales take part in two weeks of action a year - Week 1 was completed between 15th to 21st May 2023


Bradford on Avon Crime and Incident Statistics
