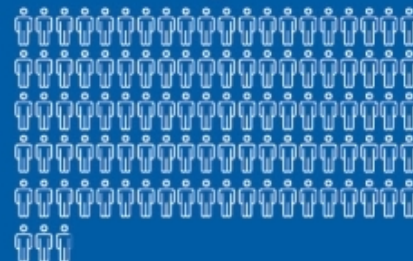

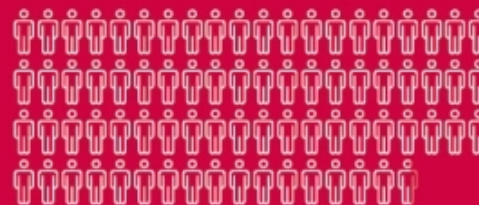

39 projects helped communities to reduce, reuse or recycle



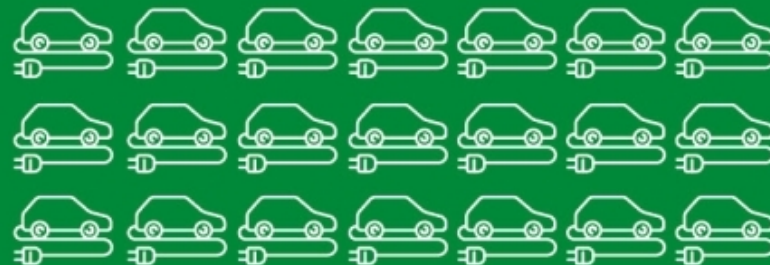
