# Application for a Premises Licence; Snack Van, Lay-by off Packway, Larkhill, Amesbury

### 1. Purpose of Report

1.1 To determine an application for a Premises Licence in respect of Snack Van made by Mr Sihman Gunduz.

# 2. Background Information

- 2.1 An application for a Premises Licence in respect of Snack Van has been made by Mr Sihman Gunduz for which one relevant representation has been received.
- 2.2 Wiltshire Council (as the Licensing Authority) must hold a hearing to consider the application having regard to the representations. In accordance with Section 18 (3) of The Licensing Act 2003 the Licensing Sub Committee is required to take such of the steps listed in 2.4 below as it considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives. In considering the application and the relevant representations, the Sub Committee must also have regard to relevant Government guidance and the Council's Licensing Policy
- 2.3 The licensing objectives are:
  - i) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder;
  - ii) Public Safety;
  - iii) The Prevention of Public Nuisance; and
  - iv) The Protection of Children from Harm.

### 2.4 Such steps are:

- To grant the licence subject to such conditions as are consistent with those included in the operating schedule submitted with the application, modified to such extent as the Sub Committee considers appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives, together with any mandatory conditions required by the Licensing Act.
- ii) To exclude from the scope of the application any licensable activity.
- iii) To reject the application.
- 2.5 On 19<sup>th</sup> April 2017 an application for a new premises licence was received and accepted as a valid application.

2.6 The details of the application as applied for is as follows:

- 2.7 A copy of the application from Mr Sihman Gunduz is attached as **Appendix 1**.
- 2.8 A plan of the location of the premises, along with the plan showing the layout of the premises is attached as **Appendix 2**.
- 2.9 The applicant has the relevant street trading consent to trade at this location Monday-Sunday 17:00-23:00hrs. An application has been made to amend these hours, in line with the hours applied for on the premises licence application. The granting of the street trading licence application will be dependent on the outcome of the licensing hearing.

#### 3. Consultation and Representations

- 3.1 The application process requires the application to be advertised, by the Applicant, in a local news publication within 10 working days, starting on the day after the authority receives it and for a public notice (on pale blue paper) to be posted on the premises. In addition the Licensing Authority advertises the application on its website, for a period of 28 consecutive days, starting the day after the authority receives the application.
- 3.2 During the consultation period one relevant representation has been received from Durrington Town Council.
- 3.3 Representations Received
  - Durrington Town Council
- 3.4 Responsible Authorities
  - No Responsible Authority has made a representation in connection with this application.
- 3.5 A summary of the representations made is detailed in the table below:

3.6 The relevant representation is attached as **Appendix 3.** 

### 4. Legal Implications

- 4.1 This hearing is governed by the Licensing Act 2003 (Hearings) Regulations. These provide that hearings should be held in public unless the Licensing Authority considers that the public interest in excluding the public outweighs the public interest in the hearing taking place in public.
- 4.2 The Applicant, and all persons who have made representations have been informed of the date, time and location of the hearing and their right to attend and be represented.
- 4.3 At the hearing all those who have made representations are entitled to address the Sub Committee and to ask questions of another party, with the consent of the Sub Committee.

#### 5. Officer Recommendations

5.1 Officers are not permitted to make a recommendation – the decision is to be reached by the members of the Licensing Sub Committee.

#### 6. Right of Appeal

- 6.1 It should be noted that the Applicant and those persons who have made representations may appeal the decision made by the Licensing Sub Committee to the Magistrates Court. The appeal must be lodged with the Magistrates Court within 21 days of the notification of the decision.
- 6.2 In the event of an appeal being lodged, the decision made by the Licensing Sub Committee remains valid until any appeal is heard and any decision made by the Magistrates Court.
- 6.3 A Responsible Authority or any person may apply to the Licensing Authority for a Review of a Premises Licence.



Dear Hannah,

Please find below the minutes from the council meeting held last night in relation to the Licensing Act 2003 application.

**Licensing Act 2003** – Application for Premise Licence at the layby The Packway, Larkhill. Hot food vending van. Late night refreshment, extension of hours Monday – Thursday 2300-0100, Friday-Saturday 2300-0300, Sunday 2300-0100. The Council considered the extension to the current hours and had concerns linked to the following:

Public Nuisance – there is concern that rubbish will be left along The Packway and verges by those purchasing from the van and not disposing of it responsibly, this can already be seen along the footpath and verge opposite and whilst probably not just from the van it's a likely contributor. There is also concern linked to the selling of drugs, whilst there has been no reports of drug issues since the current van has been using the layby, in previous years there were reports that due to its relative isolated location the layby was being used for the selling of drugs. Some Councillors believe that the extended hours may increase the possibility of this.

**Public Safety** – the van is in a layby that cannot be accessed via a footpath and is on the same side of the road at a point where the 40mph speed limit becomes a 60mph limit. Lighting is limited in the area, there is concern therefore for the safety of those pedestrians who may use the van during dark hours, particularly given the early hours of the morning when potentially those who have been drinking (this is likely to be his target audience given the times) are dropped off by taxi for food and walk back to Durrington or into Larkhill.

Can you confirm if there is a Licensing Act meeting where this application will be discussed please, if there is we may be able to send a representative.
