We aim to work with young people from established youth groups such as Cadets Guides Rangers T2a and Tidworth Girls Group to help with the planning organisation and delivery of informal educational activities for the October Family Learning Festival 2019. We will also be delivering youth work in Wellington Academy in January 2019 and when the group is established we can work with these young people towards being engaged in this project. We will focus on learning life skills such as assessing strengths and weaknesses solving problems planning time and energy coping with stress and tension negotiation resolving conflicts seeking out information and advice dealing with people in power and authority evaluating their own performances communication making decisions and carrying through agreed responsibilities. The whole community will benefit from the input of the young people to go

along side the input of the adult organizers who have already formed the networking and organisational skills needed for a project such as this. An incentive to reward the young people for their input could be a days outing of their choice after the festival. The Army Welfare Service is able to offer in kind the use of buildings equipment and delivery of some activities with qualified staff.
