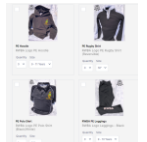

## Spring 2022

We continue to work with and for our young people as follows:

- We've come together with local partners such as the RISE Trust to extend current outreach youth provision. Young People in Royal Wootton Bassett are now able to access a safe indoor social space, free mental health support and easier access to free supplies offered by local groups and charities. Attendance at the first two weekly sessions has been strong.
- Our online ordering site has taken many orders, so we've now helped close to 400 families, including those in urgent crisis situations.
- We've continued to collect 1000s of items that are no longer needed from all our supportive local schools and library via our collection boxes, that were designed and donated by Box & Seal.
- We'll be promoting uniform ordering for those transitioning to RWBA, for summer uniform and for new school starters, via social media.
- We've made plans to run and promote our Christmas Lights Street Art wall in 2022.
- Our new website will soon be up and running. This will provide quick, convenient information on all our projects to local young people.
