- **13th January: Movie Matinée – X + Y** Nathan has amazing mathematical powers but can't relate to other people easily. When tragedy strikes the family the intervention of a maverick teacher with problems of his own helps Nathan use his powers to the full. A wonderful and moving British film starring Sally Hawkins, Rafe Spall and Eddie Marsan, with a memorable performance from Asa Butterfield as Nathan.
