The purpose of these reports is to provide a short summary of the local issues in your area. Engaging with the public is vital for us as. Not only does it give us an opportunity to share what we are doing and keep our communities informed and up to date but it also provides an opportunity for our communities to feed back to us; what we're doing well, where we can make improvements and how we can work together to tackle local issues.

As you will see on the following pages the crime/incident rates in Malmesbury have been relatively low in the previous period which is pleasing. We are also pleased to welcome to the team a new PCSO for the area, Jordan Rose, who is keen to get involved with the local community and looks forward to making contacts in the area.

Crimes that have an impact on the community

5th March 2018 to 24th April 2018

- ◇ Between 08:45 and 09:40 on the 15th March 2018 unknown Suspect(s) have entered an address on Sir Bernard Lovell Road, Malmesbury and stole a TV from within.
- ◇ Between 16:30 on the 20th March and 08:10 on the 21st March unknown suspects have entered a garage attached to a property on Newlands, Lea and stolen bikes to the value of £11,500.
- ◇ Between the 29th March at 12:00 and the 3rd April at 21:00 unknown Suspect(s) have stolen oil to the value of £300 from the tank located in the garden of an address in Brinkworth.
- ◇ Between 19:30 on the 4th April and 14:25 on the 5th April unknown Suspect(s) have entered a caravan located on the driveway of an address on Silver Street, Minety and removed 3 caravan windows, a drawer and some cushions from within.
