Project description

Replace the existing grass playing surface with an artificial green. This will create an all-weather and potentially an all year facility compared to the six months use that the present green provides. Specialist maintenance equipment will be required for the new surface

Total project costs: £135000.00

Input from Community Engagement Manager:

This group have worked with numerous partners to secure funding to deliver this project. Including discussions with Bowls England and Sport England and a professional survey that has indicated that the present green is no longer fit for purpose. This project is intended to support a recruitment drive to increase the membership and encourage a greater use of the club by social members. Bowls is a suitable sports activity for the elderly and retired an increasing element of the Malmesbury population however it is essential to encourage more general support and enthusiasm for the game. This quintessentially British sport has been played since the 16th Century and it is under threat. A more robust playing surface will allow the club to increase the existing offer of access to both local businesses for team bonding sessions and also to local community youth groups e.g. guides. They have recent experience of success with both activities. Bowls as an activity for health and enjoyment and also as a community asset. The artificial green will also provide a more suitable surface for wheelchair users and other forms of disability.
