# Warminster COVID-19 Community Response

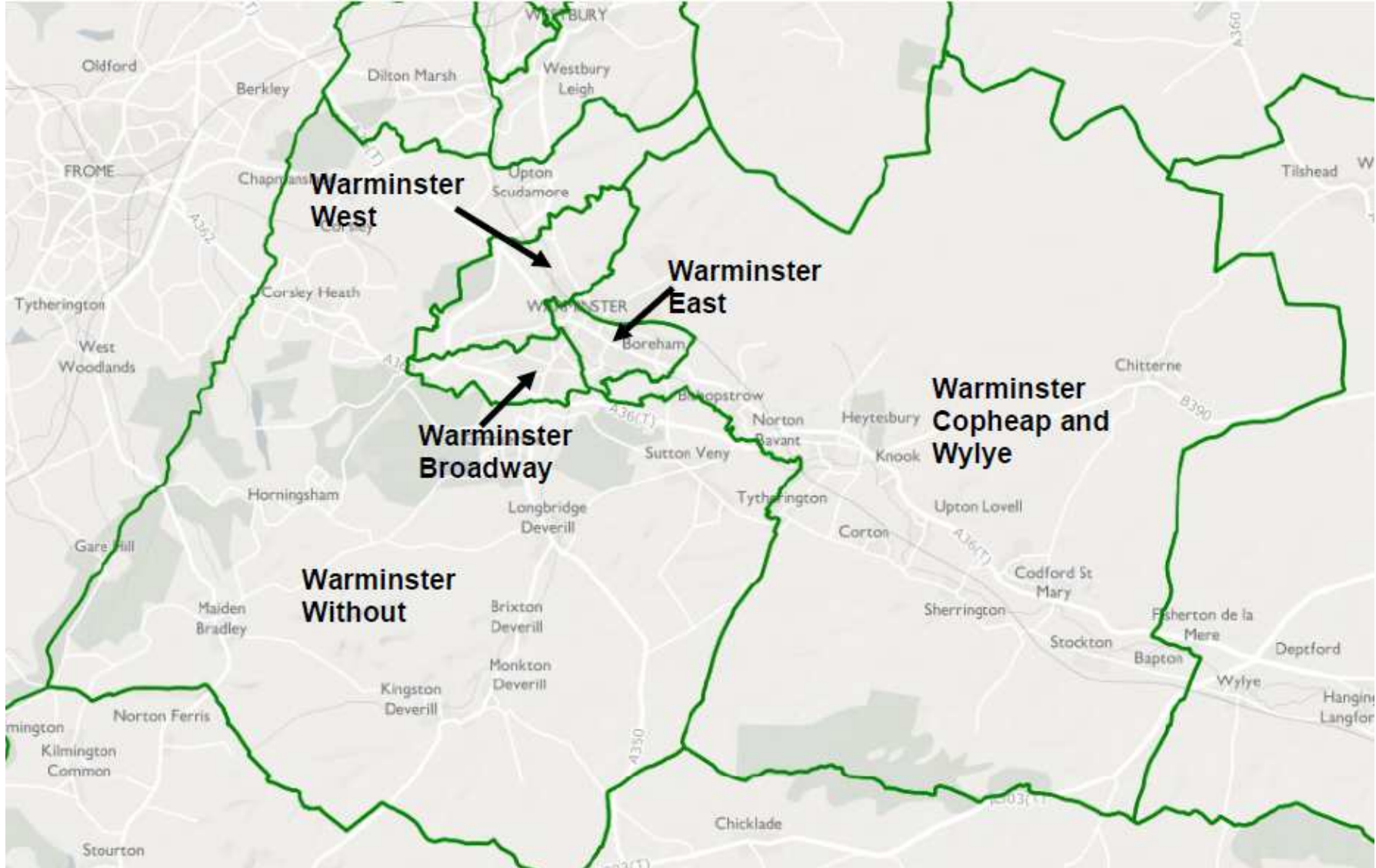
- Many volunteer groups across the community area took part in local community action

# COVID-19 Recovery

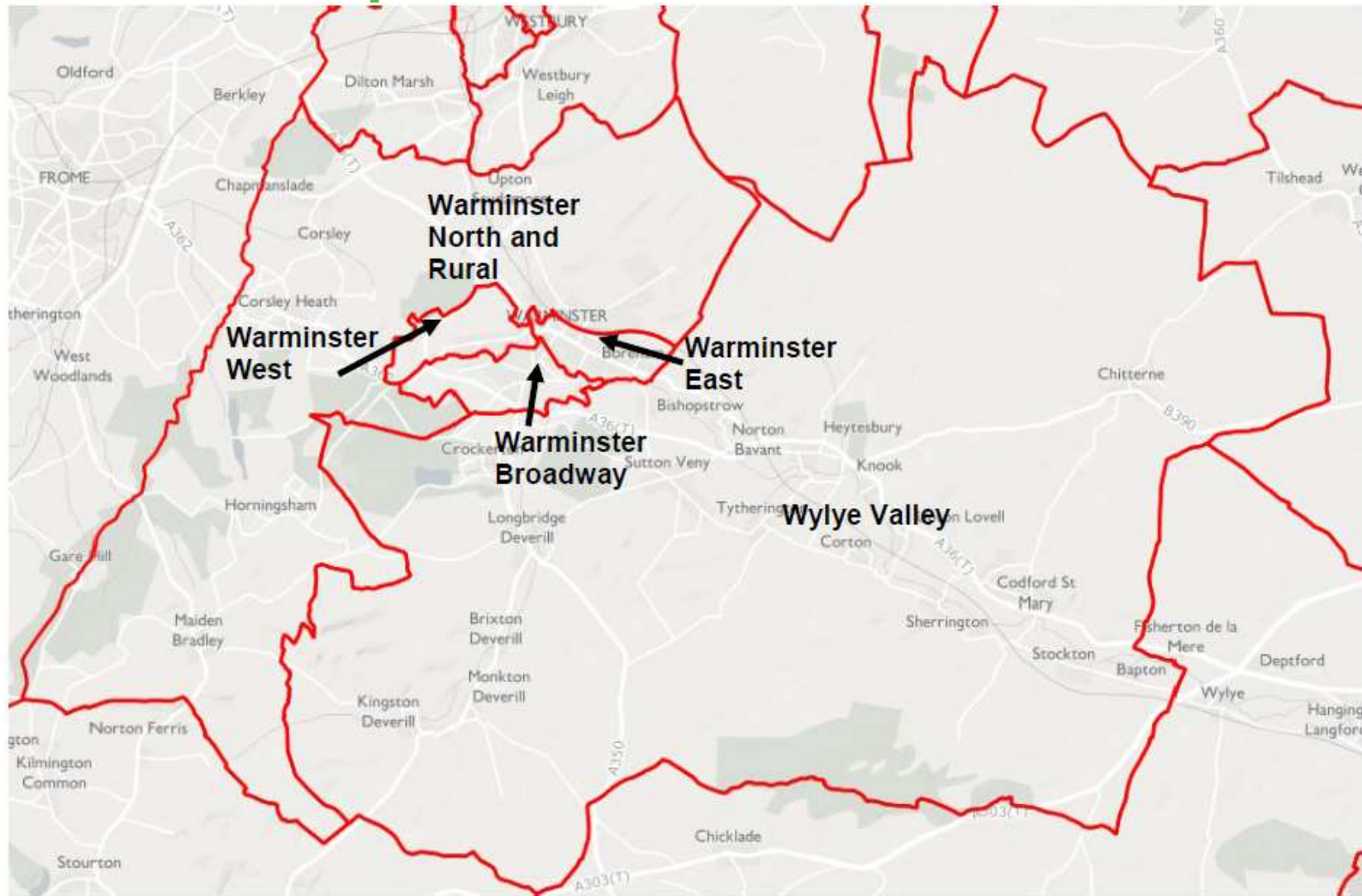
- Working towards creating a Warminster Community Area Status Report which will include:
