**Headlines/Key Issues:**

- Completion of Scoping Study of Neighbourhood Plan. Policies now being written for plan document which will go out for consultation when completed. Deadline July 2014.
- Vacancy for Councillor – election to be held 24 July
- Decisions on grants to be made at Finance and Assets meeting on 30 June – 35 applications received, total requested £43,601

**Projects:**

- Development of event in August 2015 to celebrate the 50-year anniversary of the Warminster 'Thing'. Planned UFO conference and family events.
- Collating items of memorabilia for WWI Exhibition – successful 'Finds Day' on 14 June.
- Preparations for Warminster Festival, 18 October–2 November, to include street fair on opening day.

- **27th July: Inspire live music event** – 2pm–8pm, Warminster Town Park. Five live bands and music workshops.
