How did you discover there was a need for your project (please provide evidence) and how will your project benefit your local community? Important: Please do not type/write in paragraphs – This section is limited to 1000 characters only (inclusive of spaces)	Over the years several villagers and vistors have questioned why there have not been any amateur dramatic productions in the Deverill Valley - a hotbed of talent. The village halls in Kingston and Longbridge Deverill lay on a certain amount of entertainment in the form of suppers, quiz nights and the like, but there has not been a dramatic production for over ten years. This has been partly due to there being no suitable venue - the halls are too small. An opportunity arose that the cruck barn at Manor Farm, Kingston Deverill, long used for miscellaneous agricultural storage, became available and a group was formed to put on a production. A pantomime was thought particularly fitting. As Christmas is always packed with other events, it was decided that the show should be put on in the quiet, dull month of January. There has been huge support from villagers. The venture also has the full support of the owner of Manor Farm barn, farmer Mr Richard Stratton.
