## **Wiltshire Police Licensing Report – Feta Feast Warminster**

### **Feta Feast Intelligence Reports 1<sup>st</sup> June 2012 to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2012**

Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2012

During the course of patrol on Saturday 14th July I visited Warminster CCTV and spoke to staff there.

I was advised by them that there was footage of a licensing breach at Feta Feast in the Market Place Warminster on the 24th June 2012.

I am reliably informed that the staff there closed at 0245 hrs rather than the 0200hrs licensed closing time. I have secured the footage and will be reporting this to the Licensing Team at Trowbridge Police Station.

Further to this I paid my own visit to Feta Feast at 0155hrs on Sunday the 15th July and spoke with staff there re their closing time. Whilst there was yet more confusion about serving of last customers I informed them it was quite clear there was no more money/orders to be made and the premises had to stop trading at 02.00hrs.

Last customers needed to leave the shop as soon as possible.

I remained and watched the shop and by 0210 the premises was empty and closed.

I am told by staff that they are seeking to take over the license from Sid THNAIBAT and that they will be asking to stay open until 0300hrs. It is quite clear the same staff have been working in the premises the whole time the licensing breaches have continued and I would have no confidence that any further breaches wouldn't occur.

The same issues re FETA exist and they remain susceptible to disorder.
