Item 7(d) – 13/03489/FUL – Goldenley Care Home, Forest Lane, Chippenham, SN15 3QU

Amended layout plan received on the 3rd Jan 2014. This plan indicates the amended car parking spaces 15. The spaces comply with the Highway Engineers requirements in terms of numbers and reduce the likely number of vehicles accessing the site. They are located outside the pipeline access corridor.

Two further letters have been received since amended plans were submitted and neighbours re-notified:

The issues raised are in general in line with those received in relation to the original submission. The objectors consider the amended plans do not overcome their concerns particularly in relation to traffic generation, road safety, impact on adjacent residents and site layout.

The applicant has submitted information in respect of the pipeline.

An email from Brendan Dempsey Pipeline Technician dated 2.01.14 confirms that the proposal will not affect the wayleave/easement in association with the pipeline. There should not be any parking within the area. No objection is raised.
