Cricklade and Purton Councils have joined forces to share a Dog Awareness Week, 7<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2015. The campaign is being supported from funds from the Area Board, leading on from the work undertaken by the Dog Fouling Task Group.

- Tesco has announced the withdrawal of their planning application for a store in the neighbouring parish of Lydiard Tregoze. Planning applications for 320 homes and a retail store are still being considered by Wiltshire Council.
- The Christmas Lights and Shopping Event 2014 was extremely successful and well attended.
- Gabriela Stanciu and David Wilson of Network Rail made a presentation to Royal Wootton Bassett Councillors at a meeting in December 2014 on the planned bridge closures in the Royal Wootton Bassett area to allow for the electrification of the Great Western Railway line.

### **Projects**
