## Project Description:

A section of the existing footpath has become narrowed and unsafe. There is concern older people visually impaired walkers or children could slip down the bank adjacent to the footpath and injure themselves. This is a PIG request. The length of improvement measures 140 metres by 1 metre. 6 metres of this length requires timber and post supports. 2 steps will be created at the start of the path for ease of access and safety.

## Input from Community Engagement Manager:

A footpaths scheme so fits with our priorities. Parish Clerk identified the parish could contribute if required up to £100.
