DEVERILL ROAD, WARMINSTER ORDER: PROPOSED WAITING RESTRICTIONS

Purpose of Report

To:

- (i) Consider objections to the advertised proposals for parking controls at Deverill Road, Warminster.
- (ii) Recommend the making of the Traffic Regulation Order as Advertised.

Consultation

The Deverill Road parking proposal was generated during the latest Town Centre Parking Review undertaken in Warminster. This particular location had not been picked up during the full town centre review, but was picked up following the review.

During the advertisement period a total of four items of correspondence were received in response to the proposals contained within the advertised Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). Of those four letters received, two objected the scheme and two commented on the proposal.

Details of correspondence can be found in **Appendix 1** together with a summary of comments. Officer response to the comments can be found in **Appendix 2**.

Options Considered

To:

- (i) Implement the proposal as advertised.
- (ii) Not implement the proposal.
- (iii) Implement the proposal with amendments.

Reason for Decision

The comments set out in Appendix 2 on the various objections received indicate that it is considered appropriate to introduce the scheme as advertised.

DECISION MADE

I approve that:

- (i) The restrictions be implemented as advertised.
- (ii) The objectors be informed accordingly.

This decision was published on 13 April 2018 and will come into force on 21 April 2018.
