Following on from the decision of Purton, Lyneham & Bradenstoke and Lydiard Tregoz to leave the NEW-V

grouping for Neighbourhood Planning, Lydiard Millicent finds itself in a position whereby it has no contiguous boundaries with the remaining parishes of Tockenham, Clyffe Pypard and Broad Town, and therefore will have to apply for a separate Designated Area.

There is a small amount of Frontrunner funding which is available to the NEW-V group, which is not available to those parishes who leave NEW-V.

As Lydiard Millicent has not chosen to leave, but is unable to continue with NEW-V due to its lack of contiguous boundary

IT IS PROPOSED THAT LYDIARD MILLICENT HAS THE SAME ACCESS TO THE NEW-V FRONTRUNNER FUNDING AS IT WOULD HAVE HAD AS PART OF THE NEW-V GROUPING.
