#### 42 **Polling District and Polling Place Review**

Caroline Rudland, Electoral Services Specialist Manager provided information on the upcoming Polling District and Polling Place Review, which would commence on 2 October 2023 if the Committee was in agreement.

The aim of the review was to ensure the electoral arrangements for Wiltshire meet the needs of the electorate. The majority of polling district changes proposed in the review were rectifying some very small polling districts that were created as a result of Community Governance Reviews and the Unitary boundary changes in 2021.

It was explained that all responses to the consultation on the review would be collated and assessed, would be reported to the Committee at its next meeting, and if changes were then approved the revised electoral register would be published on 1 December 2023. The consultation would seek the views of the public, key stakeholders, partners, and elected members. Any new community buildings which could be used in future elections would be a useful outcome.

Details were provided on the consultation including paper copies available from council hubs, that representations were required to be published, and that people could phone and make a verbal representation. The consultation would run from 2 October to 31 October 2023, as set out in appendices A, B and C to the report included within the agenda.

The importance of where people vote was discussed, and clarity was sought on whether the review encompassed changes from recent community governance reviews. It was explained where these were complete, they could be taken into account, however the most recent would take effect from May 2025, and in some cases had not received final consent for division changes, so minor adjustments would be made through a rolling programme of changes. There were also questions relating to updating all elected members and engaging with parish councils.

At the conclusion of discussion, it was,

#### Resolved:

- To authorise the Director, Legal and Governance, in consultation with the Chairman of the Electoral Review Committee, to carry out the consultation in accordance with the arrangements outlined in the report.
- 2) To consider for approval at a future meeting, the final recommendations following the conclusion of the consultation.

#### 43 Community Governance Review 2023/24

The Democracy Manager and the Senior Democratic Services Officer provided verbal updates on the progress of the 2023/24 Community Governance Review.

It was confirmed the terms of reference for the 2023/24 review was published on 11 September 2023. This listed the areas for review, the limited nature of the review in respect of North Bradley and Lacock, and the capability to include additional areas to correct minor anomalous boundaries which may be identified. A briefing note would be circulated shortly, and sessions arranged for potentially impacted parishes for the more significant proposals, and with unitary members.

The Committee discussed the update, seeking clarity on local members being able to flag up any anomalous boundaries in their area, and confirmation that in many areas this might require subsequent electoral division changes, which was the responsibility of the Local Government Boundary Commission for England. The Committee also reviewed the information sheets for each area, including details of currently received proposals and electorate information.

#### **Polling District and Polling Place Review 2023**

#### **Purpose**

- 1. The Committee is required to review the current polling districts and polling places by considering
  - The (Acting) Returning Officer ((A)RO) comments and initial proposals
  - The comments received during the consultation period
  - The (A)RO final recommendations.
- 2. This information is provided in the following supporting documents:
  - a. Appendix A Overall report Proposed polling arrangements following the public consultation
  - b. Appendix B Summary of responses and (A)RO recommendations.
- 3. The committee must approve a final polling district and polling place scheme which will come into force from 1 December 2023 when the electoral register is revised.

#### **Background**

- 4. The Council is required by the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 to undertake a compulsory review of UK Parliamentary polling districts and polling places which must be started and completed between 1 October 2023 and 31 January 2025 (inclusive).
- 5. The Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 amended the Representation of the People Act 1983 to require relevant authorities to undertake regular reviews of both polling districts and polling places within its area. The definitions between a district, place and station are:
  - A **polling district** is a geographical sub-division of an electoral area (an electoral area being a UK Parliamentary constituency, a European Parliamentary electoral region, a parish, parish ward or an electoral division).
  - A polling place is the building or area in which polling stations will be selected by the Returning Officer. A polling place within a polling district must be designated so that polling stations are within easy reach of all electors from across the polling district.
  - A polling station is the actual area where the process of voting takes place
    and must be located within the polling place designated for the particular
    polling district. The Returning Officer for the particular election must provide a
    sufficient number of polling stations and allocate the electors to those polling
    stations in such a manner as they think is the most convenient.
- 6. Due to the geographical size of Wiltshire Council and the number of polling districts

to review, the reports and consultation have been categorised into unitary division areas for easier identification of locations and areas.

### **Summary of the review proposals**

7. There are 98 Unitary Divisions in Wiltshire.


#### **Public consultation**

- 8. The public consultation took place from 2 October to 31 October 2023. Copies of the public consultation document were available online, by request, and paper copies were available at libraries in each of the Parliamentary constituencies.
- 9. Invitations to engage with the review were made in writing to:
  - Political Parties
  - Elected Representatives in Wiltshire
  - Groups identified as being under-represented by the Electoral Commission in elections
  - Organisations deemed to have an interest in the review (for example Parish Councils)
- 10. The review was publicised and promoted in a variety of ways including a social media campaign, information to Area Boards, town and parish newsletters, Wiltshire Councillor newsletters, internal One Council newsletter, posters in Wiltshire libraries, press releases, Wiltshire Council website and Wiltshire Council residents e-newsletter.

#### **Consultation responses**

11. There were 53 representations received during the consultation process. All of the comments from the review can be found in Appendix A under the relevant Unitary Division for consideration.


12. The map below plots the areas of Wiltshire where the representations from the public consultation came from.



- 13. Comments were received about 34 of the Unitary Divisions, 11 of which had no proposed changes, 23 of which had proposed changes.
- 14. A mixture of positive and constructive representations were made and while there were a cluster of responses received around Salisbury, otherwise the representations came from across the county.
- 15. Seven representations confirmed that electors were happy with the polling stations they vote at.

#### Source of representations

16. The majority of responses (72%) were from individual electors.



#### **Proposals for approval:**

- 17. There are 3 categories for the Committee to consider for approval:
  - a. Unitary Divisions where no changes were proposed to polling districts and there are no relevant comments to be considered from the public consultation. Any proposed changes in this category relate to polling stations only.
  - b. Unitary Divisions where changes were proposed to the polling districts
  - c. Particular consideration and discussion to be given to the two Unitary Divisions of Sherston and Warminster North & Rural
- 18. A list of the Unitary Divisions which fall under these 3 categories is provided below. A summary table in Appendix B is also provided which includes the Responses from the (Acting) Returning Officer to the public consultation comments.




#### **Sherston**

- 19. The Committee is asked to consider the electoral arrangements for the Sherston Unitary Division taking into consideration the comments received from the public consultation and the (A)RO response.
- 20. The parish of Luckington currently comprises of two polling districts OO1 and OP1. The electorate of OO1 is 83 and the electorate of OP1 is 439 electors. Each polling district currently has a polling station venue.
- 21. The (A)RO proposed that the two polling districts are merged into one for the whole parish and that Luckington Village Hall is the designated polling station. Whilst the polling station for OO1 is convenient for their 83 electors, Luckington Village Hall is situated centrally within the Parish. The two Village Halls are approximately 1.1 miles away from each other.
- 22. One response to the public consultation was received for this parish where they have asked for the polling station for OO1 to remain and the polling districts not to merge. The Committee is asked to consider the (A)RO recommendation from the review or keep the current electoral arrangements as per the response from the public consultation



#### **Warminster North & Rural**

- 23. The Committee is asked to consider the electoral arrangements for the Warminster North & Rural Unitary Division taking into consideration the comments received from the public consultation and the (A)RO response.
- 24. The minor boundary change proposal between IC1 and IC2 has been revoked from the review as it is deemed to be unnecessary.
- 25. The Committee is asked to consider the suggestion from the review that it is not preferable for electors voting in IC2 to vote in person at the Warminster Garrison. The consequence of this would mean the Committee allowing a polling place outside of the Unitary Division. The (A)RO recommends that if this is the decision of the Committee that the polling station would be Warminster Civic Centre.

#### 26. The Committee is asked to approve:

- The Unitary Divisions where no changes were proposed to polling districts and there are no relevant comments to be considered from the public consultation. Any proposed changes in this category relate to polling stations only.

- The outcome for the Unitary Division of Warminster North & Rural

### 1. INTRODUCTION

Talne Without Parish Council would like to thank Wiltshire Council for consulting with us on polling districts and polling stations within the Parish.

 $\overset{\longleftarrow}{\omega}$  have no comments to make about arrangements for polling stations, which currently seem satisfactory.

We would, however, like to draw your attention to the need for significant changes to polling districts which will be required due to the significant changes to parish boundaries arising out of the 2021/22 Community Governance Review, undertaken by Wiltshire Council.

This is due to be implemented in May 2025, with parts of Calne Without Parish Council being transferred to Calne Town Council and the Parish Councils of Bremhill, Hilmarton, Compton Bassett, Cherhill and Heddington, and the remainder becoming the new Parish of Derry Hill & Studley.

These proposed changes are detailed in full in the following Wiltshire Council document:


There is, however, a further complication that Wiltshire Council should be aware of. The Calne Community Neighbourhood Plan is currently undergoing a major review. This Neighbourhood Plan currently covers the areas of Calne Town Council and Calne Without Parish Council. The updated Neighbourhood Plan is likely to proceed to a referendum in early 2025, and potentially on the same date as the May 2025 town and parish council elections.

The new polling district structure therefore needs to be able to facilitate both town and parish council elections to the new boundaries, potentially at the same time as facilitating a Neighbourhood Plan referendum reflecting the current boundaries.

Detailed recommendations for each of the current polling districts within Calne Without are detailed in Section 2 below.

### 2. DETAILED RECOMMENDATIONS

The future Parish of Derry Hill and Studley will then comprise the following three electoral divisions

Derry Hill and Studley Ward, comprising the remainder of the MU1 division, following transfers out.

- Pewsham Ward, comprising the NB1 division, largely unchanged, except for the minor adjustment noted above.
- Bowood and Sandy Lane Ward, comprising the MV1 division, expanded to include transfers from MU1 (West Ward), MT2 (Middle Ward) and SK1 (Bromham).

The newly created wards within Heddington and Cherhill Parish Councils will be drawn from:

- Stockley Ward of Heddington PC, taken from the former Middle Ward divisions of MT1 and MT2 after transfers.
- Blackland & Calstone Ward of Cherhill PC, taken from the former East Ward division of MQ1.
- Lower Compton Ward of Cherhill PC, requiring a new electoral division.

Additional electoral divisions will be required to facilitate a referendum on the Calne Community Neighbourhood Plan:

- Within Bremhill Parish Council, covering Area D1 taken from the former West Ward.
- Within Compton Bassett Parish Council, covering Area H1 taken from the former East Ward.

# 99 Appendix B (Wilcot, Huish & Oare)

Good evening,

The parish council appreciates that the review process has remembered their previous comments about this matter, made during the 2019/2020 Community Governance Review.

Since then, of course, the parameters of decision-making have changed for the parish, with the introduction of charges for all electoral costs to be borne by the parish rather than by Wiltshire Council.

Ideally, if the costs are not prohibitive, the parish council would prefer that two polling stations are operated, with both Wilcot and Oare Village Halls open to voters; this would enhance access and facilitate participation in the electoral process for those unable to drive, as well as facilitating walking and cycling for all voters in line with Wiltshire Council's environmental strategy.

If the costs are prohibitive, the parish council would, as a second-best option, ask for alternating polling stations, in order to share the burden of travel equally between parishioners.

The parish council seeks to know whether the mergen

The parish council seeks to know whether the merger to create one polling district restricts these options. In which case, the parish council would ask that the merger is reconsidered.

The parish council would appreciate further discussion and an understanding of the costs before any decisions are taken by Wiltshire Council, please.

The parish council wonders whether Wiltshire Council would be willing to negotiate a deal, whereby the electoral costs to the parish could be offset by the environmental benefits to Wiltshire of operating two stations.

# 100 Appendix C (Wiltshire County)

Email from an Elector in Wiltshire

Hello,

My comments do not relate to any particular polling place, they note experiences people from the affected groups have frequently reported across the country. This indicates that the training of Polling Officers should explicitly include these scenarios so they can react correctly and appropriately. (And if it already does, that they should be stressed or given more prominence so that the Polling Officers are more aware of these situations.)

Regarding the LGBTQ+ Community; If someone has an ID that does not match their gender presentation – Say someone wearing make up, with a dress and long hair had an ID with an M marker and the name Steve – they are frequently challenged on the basis that this is not their real ID. In reality there are a host of reasons why someone may not have wanted or been able to get an ID that matches the way they prefer to present themselves.

Even if a Poll worker is aware of trans, non-binary and gender non-conforming people, they may feel entitled to ask intrusive questions to confirm the person is 'really trans.' This puts the person in the awkward position of refusing to answer, and potentially being turned away, or having to disclose private intermediate.

Addition, some polling places are in old or hard to reach buildings, with only a few parking spaces. Even if there is a ramp/a lack of steps, getting to the building itself can be an issue for those who use wheelchairs or have other mobility challenges. Narrow doorways and corridors can still be a barrier to be building is overall considered 'accessible'. Ideally someone who uses a wheelchair would have the final say over whether or not a building was considered suitable.

Another consideration is that if the polling place is busy, there are not always chairs available for those who cannot stand for long periods and who are therefore unable to wait if there is a queue.

Also those with speech or mental difficulties are sometimes challenged because it is believed they don't or aren't capable of understanding what they are voting for, and therefore do not have the right to vote. They are then mistakenly prevented from exercising their legal right.

Then there are those from immigrant communities, who may not speak English fluently, who nevertheless have the right to vote, either in Local or National elections. Sometimes they are challenged based on the mistaken assumption that such a person could not be a citizen, or should not have the right to vote. Their English skills mean they are unable to dispute the Polling Officer and so are wrongly turned away.

If a person has encountered one of these issues previously or knows someone who has, it can discourage them from making another attempt to vote.

Therefore, ideally, you would make it clear in your advertising/information that the issues have been considered and you are actively trying to avoid them in

future. In addition, polling paces and voting information should make it clear where people can address any queries or complaints if they do have an issue with a Polling place or Officer.

# 101 Appendix D (Warminster North & Rural)

Dear Election Team,

You have invited comments from councillors familiar with the polling stations and polling districts within each Unitary Division.

I refer to specifically Warminster IC1 and IC2.

IC2 is situated in the Community Centre, Firbank Crescent within the Garrison near residential quarters.

Although not 'behind the wire' it serves a minority of nearby 'service' voters and is not a conducive location for the much larger number of voters from IC2 to travel there to attend.

Indeed, with the rightful secure areas within the garrison camp, it can be somewhat intimidating and confusing to find.

I suggest that the following suggestion are considered:

- The polling station is relocated to withing IC2 (Portway Estate Medilcot House)
- An additional polling station is set up in IC2 (as above)
- Polling station in IE2 Warminster Civic Centre is set up to jointly receive voters from IC2 (which would be nearer to travel)

I hope that you will receive these comments in the constructive manor intended but happy to discuss further.

# 102 Appendix E (Harnham West)

The community lounge has been used since the Junior school ceased being used, due to the TRO coming into being in the road in around 2006, which bans non permit holders. The lounge is also within the old sheltered scheme and closer to many who are likely not to bother to vote. It is also owned by wc, so there should not be any cost in hire fees.

I was advised that the lounge was not used during covid and should return to use as a polling station.

### **Parish Name Change Review**

### **Purpose**

1. To consider proposals to change the name of the parish of Lea & Cleverton.

### **Background**

- 2. Changing the name of a parish or parish council can be done through a Community Governance Review process in accordance with the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007.
- 3. However, such a change may also be progressed under s.75 of the Local Government Act 1972.
- 4. As the latter would be a simpler process in terms of structure, consultation and decision, the Committee at its meeting on 21 September 2021 resolved that where a request was received solely regarding a parish name change, the s.75 process would be followed
- 5. This report relates to requests from the parish of Lea & Cleverton, which is located east of Malmesbury, within the Electoral Division of Brinkworth.

#### **Main Considerations**

6. Lea & Cleverton Parish Council requested that the name of the parish be changed to Lea, Garsdon, & Cleverton Parish Council. The reason for the request was:

To properly represent the three habited areas that make up our parish

- 7. In order to change the name of a parish, a decision would be required by Full Council, who would then notify the Secretary of State, Director General of the Ordnance Survey, and the Registrar General, along with a parish name change order.
- 8. There are no specific consultation requirements where a change of parish name is being considered under s.75, only proscribed notifications after the event as detailed above.
- 9. However, the Council must have reasonable grounds for making a change that has been proposed by a parish council. On this basis Lea & Cleverton Parish Council were informed on 19 October 2023 that an online survey had been set up to seek any local views, with a request this be circulated in the community. The Members of Malmesbury Area Board were also contacted on 23 October 2023. The council's webpage on reviews was updated to include the name change survey.
- 10. S.75 allows the Council to change the name of a parish at the request of a parish council (or parish meeting if there is no council). This means that the Council may only approve or not approve that suggested name, and cannot substitute some other

- proposal. For instance, should a new suggestion arise as a result of a survey, unless the parish council had indicated formal consent for that alternative proposal.
- 11.1 response was received to the parish council's proposal. This was in favour, stating the proposed name was more inclusive.
- 12. The Committee has recommended, and Council approved, name changes in the past where no responses were received.
