

DECISION NOTICE

Southern Area Licensing Sub Committee

Decision made on 07 August 2012

In respect of an application for a Premises Licence made by Wiltshire Council for Wilton Development Centre for Young People, The Hollows, Wilton, SP2 0JE

Decision:

The Southern Area Licensing Sub Committee has resolved to GRANT the licence for the following licensable activities:

B - Films E - Live music F - Recorded music G - Performance of dance H - Anything of a similar description to that falling within (e), (f) or (g). And subject to the following additional conditions:

1. Prominent, clear and legible notices must be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly and not loiter close to the entrance.

Reasons

The Sub Committee have considered the written evidence presented in the agenda together with the oral evidence given at the hearing, noting in particular the concerns of the representations in respect of noise disturbance, criminal damage and increased traffic.

The Sub Committee considered that no evidence was produced to substantiate these concerns and that no formal complaints had been received by the Police or Wiltshire Council.

The Sub Committee noted that it would be recommended that a contact number for any concerns regarding licensable activities be displayed on the premises.

The Sub Committee also considered the additional imposed condition would be sufficient to address the concerns of representations regarding noise levels, and therefore meet the licensing objectives.

In reaching its decision the Sub Committee has considered the relevant provisions of the Licensing Act 2003 (in particular Sections 4 and 18); the guidance issued under Section 182 of the Act and the Licensing Policy of Wiltshire Council.

The granting of this licence is without prejudice to any other consents or approvals that may be required.

Right to Appeal

All parties have the right to appeal to the Magistrates Court within 21 days of receipt of this decision.
