4. What is the Community benefit/evidence of need/links to Community Plan/Community Issue?

The Trowbridge Cultural Food Festival first ever event was held last September, 2015, at Longfield Community Centre and was a huge success with over 200 people sampling our members food on a paid premise.

Due to the positive engagement at this event we are keen to continue promoting the cultural diversity of Trowbridge and have agreed to host a tent at this year Olympic day. To enable the community to get the most from the event we need exhibition materials to say more about the different cultures present and their food cultures. Information and education is an important part of developing community cohesion and the materials can be used for this and other events into the future.

The food will be 60pence per portion, funded by various small local specialised supermarkets and Tesco's, the proceeds will go to charities.
