LEC (Wiltshire) is part of a National Charity (Coram Life Education) that works closely with primary schools to encourage children to be aware of themselves through programmes which focus on building positive attitudes. The LEC programmes support the objectives set out in the National Framework for PSHE & Citizenship & were recognised in OFSTED 2002 Reports for delivering effective drug education to schools.L LEC has been operating in Wiltshire since 1997 following the monies raised by the Mayor of Salisbury 1995/1996 and operated by Wiltshire County Council, since 2002 the service has been run by a local charity/trust of volunteers. Many local schools already benefit from regular visits of our mobile classroom, Teachers, school governors, parents & carers are encouraged to call into the mobile when visiting the schools to enhance their understanding of the subjects discussed.

Until July 2010 we have been in partnership with Wiltshire Council who provided a part time educator, however due to budget cuts this has been withdrawn. This will inevidently cause us financial difficulties without further funding from other sources.

We also work closely with the Community Safety Partnership & The Police in providing the needs of educating children on these difficult subjects.
