Consultation took place with local schools and colleges in the lead up to the acquisition of the land for the farm and during the months following the hand-over of the land from Laverstock and Ford Parish Council to the farm. We also received feedback from the public following our Open Day in June 2010. The development of the farmyard was identified as essential in allowing easy managed access for educational visits and for the community and for providing a suitable environment for work experience. Without a proper farmyard and car parking area we cannot easily invite schools, colleges, community groups and the general public to the farm and we can only have a limited number of animals on site. At the moment the ground is uneven and unsafe and we ane not able to accomodate certain groups eg the visually impaired, wheelchair users and the elderly. Enquiries made with all groups wanting to viist the farm has identified the desire to see an accessible working farm in place with more animals on site and space for community events eg barn dance
