- Lydiard Millicent Parish Council has been working very hard recently to set up a Steering Group to produce a Neighbourhood Plan for the Parish. As a result of Lydiard Tregoz removing themselves from the NEW-V group Lydiard Millicent is now no longer able to continue either. Wiltshire Council will be inviting comments on our LMAP Neighbourhood Plan Designated Area very shortly.
- The 2016/17 season for Lydiard Millicent Junior Football Club started on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> September. Adult volunteers and managers have marked out four pitches and a couple of friendly matches had been played to "test the ground"! Thank you to all the volunteers who helped with preparation for this season.
