

# APPENDIX 3

**Planting Notes:**  
 All woodland restoration areas shall be planted with trees and shrubs to be selected from the following species list:

- Acer campestre* (Field Maple)
- Alnus glutinosa* (Alder)
- Betula pubescens* (Downy Birch)
- Carpinus betulus* (Hornbeam)
- Castanea sativa* (Sweet Chestnut) or *Fagus sylvatica* (Beech) depending on soil chemistry
- Corylus avellana* (Hazel)
- Crataegus monogyna* (Hawthorn)
- Ilex aquifolium* (Holly)
- Quercus robur* (Oak)
- Sorbus aucuparia* (Rowan)
- Viburnum opulus* (Guelder Rose)

The oak, hornbeam and sweet chestnut (or beech) will provide the basis of a commercial crop, whilst shrubs and other tree species will be planted on the woodland edges, along woodland rides and adjacent to ponds to provide diversity.

Advance planting areas on the margins of the site will comprise a mix of the following species:

- Acer campestre* (Field Maple)
- Alnus glutinosa* (Alder)
- Betula pubescens* (Downy Birch)
- Carpinus betulus* (Hornbeam)
- Corylus avellana* (Hazel)
- Crataegus monogyna* (Hawthorn)
- Pinus sylvestris* (Scots Pine)
- Prunus avium* (Wild Cherry)
- Prunus spinosa* (Blackthorn)
- Quercus robur* (Oak)
- Salix cinerea* (Sallow)
- Sorbus aucuparia* (Rowan)
- Viburnum opulus* (Guelder Rose)

All planting stock shall comprise 600-900mm bare rooted transplants to be notch planted and protected with appropriate tree and shrub guards to protect against deer and vermin. Each guard should be secured using a square section hardwood timber stake using integral ratchet ties.

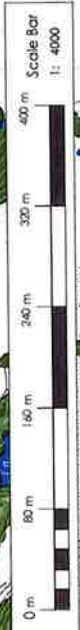
All planting areas shall be maintained for a period of 5 year following planting as part of a statutory after-care scheme to be approved by the Mineral Planning Authority.

Agricultural restoration areas shall be cultivated following soil placement and shall be seeded with a short term agricultural grass ley. A programme of agricultural management during the 5 year aftercare period will be agreed with the Planning Authority and the land owners.
