The beginner band is aimed at musicians who can play 3 notes to grade 2 standard and the second band will cover from grade 2 onwards. This pilot project will take place after school.

Through the band rehearsals and concerts, I aim to bring military and civilian communities together and build a stronger sense of community by working together.

**How did you discover there was a need for your project and how will your project benefit your local community?**

The Wiltshire Music Service has just appointed me as Team Leader for East Wiltshire. Part of my job is to develop ensembles in the area. Having worked and lived in this area all my life, I feel now is the right time as I have enough good students at Wellington Academy to support an Intermediate Wind Band. Also, with the funding from the government given to all music services to develop the Wider Opportunities programmes by giving money for instruments, we now have the resources to kick start instrumental learning in schools and so we are currently teaching 100 children clarinets and brass to year 5 students in a Wider Opportunities setting. The Wiltshire Music Service has provided 39 instruments which will be used every year to start off each new year 5 group. The aim is to give something for the local children to do, whether is practising their instruments at home, being at rehearsal, or being involved in a concert. Concerts hope to involve other groups in the Kennet area, the Lucknow Band or the choirs from the local schools. For this pilot project the subscription fee will be free and I hope to raise the profile of the area by involving the media.

**Any other information about your project.**

The children borrow the instruments for free. Government funding permitting, each subsequent year 5 group could have the opportunity to learn initially in this way and then feed into the wind band and we could continue it if all goes well. Wellington Academy are funding the minibuses to get the children to and from the rehearsals. The school is also providing the premises for free. Kennet Young Musicians is providing the music and I have to find the funding to cover the cost of my time. So I am asking for the money to cover for my teaching hours and to give the children who cannot afford it an instrument to play in September when the new year 5 intake start their Wider Opportunities Programme. The prices shown are based on current prices from the John Packer website. Prices change a lot and with a bulk order we should be able to negotiate an even better deal.

It hoped that the children continue to play and take it up at Wellington Academy and build on the success of the music department there. I would like for it to be the talk of the community with the regular concerts we will be doing as well as the links with the army band.
